Option 2: Station open at all times, except in emergencies. Rank: _____

- ❖ *Duration of Project: 24 months*
- ❖ *One elevator will be repaired at a time. Two elevators will be in operation.*
- ❖ *Trains will only be required to skip the station in emergencies, if one or more of the operating elevators fail. Past experience would suggest this might happen about once or twice a month.*

Option 3: Station closed during off-peak times, open during peak times except in emergencies. Rank: _____

- ❖ *Duration of Project: 22 months*
- ❖ *One elevator will be repaired at a time. Two elevators will be in operation.*
- ❖ *Station will be open at peak times but closed at off-peak times, with all trains skipping the station in both directions.*
- ❖ *Trains may also be required to skip the station during peak times in emergencies, if one or more of the operating elevators fail. Past experience would suggest this might happen about once or twice a month.*
